

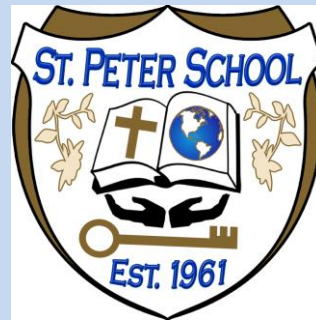
St. Peter School Mission Statement

New Student Registration
Information

Students Entering Kindergarten

- Students must be 5 on or before August 31st of the Kindergarten year.
- Applications for fall admission will be available from the school in late January of the preceding school year and screenings will be held during the early spring.
- Notices of Acceptance will be sent out after screenings.
- Kindergarten Orientation will be held in August.

Transfer Students in Grades 1-6

- Registrations are accepted from January to July 1st prior to the first day of the transfer year.
- For First Grade, students must be 6 on or before September 1st of the First Grade year.
- Students will not be admitted during the halfway point of the year without due cause and approval.
- Transfer admissions will be based on principal interviews and review of students' past school history to determine whether the student can meet the academic and behavioral expectations of the school and the school's ability to meet the students' needs. A probation period usually required.

All New Students Must Provide

- Immunization Records
- Baptismal/Sacrament Records
- Copies of any Custodial Agreements
- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Previous School Records (transfers)
- \$25 Registration Fee

Tuition Information

The cost to educate a student at St. Peter School is approximately \$5500 per year. Our tuition is set at \$5500. Families apply for scholarship After these scholarships, each family is expected to pay the Family Participation amounts as follows:
